- ◆ To conjugate, first look to see if your verb has an *-ar*, *-er*, or *-ir* ending.
- ◆ Then, depending on who is doing the action, choose the correct conjugation for that ending.

-AR

yo	o	nosotros, nosotras	amos
tú	as	vosotros, vosotras	áis
él, ella, usted	a	ellos, ellas, ustedes	an

-ER

yo	o	nosotros, nosotras	emos
tú	es	vosotros, vosotras	éis
él, ella, usted	e	ellos, ellas, ustedes	en

-IR

yo	o	nosotros, nosotras	imos
tú	es	vosotros, vosotras	ís
él, ella, usted	e	ellos, ellas, ustedes	en

- ◆ We will be using the verbs from the "*Me gusta*" packet. I would like to add a few verbs to the list.

asistir (a una clase) = to attend (a class)

escribir = to write

recibir (cartas) = to receive (letters)

vivir = to live

- ◆ 4 of the verbs from the "*Me gusta*" packet have irregular conjugations. Below are their conjugations. Please star these four verbs in your "*Me gusta*" packet so that you will remember to look here when conjugating them.

hacer (la tarea): hago, haces, hace, hacemos, hacéis, hacen

ir: voy, vas, va, vamos, vais, van

jugar: juego, juegas, juega, jugamos, jugáis, juegan

esquiar: esquío, esquías, esquía, esquiamos, esquíais, esquían
